All the curriculum is conducted in English.





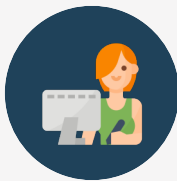

# ADMISSION & SCHOLARSHIP



# Admission Requirements

## Freshmen

Incoming freshman must hold a high school diploma or higher at the beginning of the first term.

## Transfer students

Must have completed at least four semesters at a four-year college or university, or have completed a degree at a two or three year college (AA/AS)

## Nationality

Neither the applicant nor either of their parents may hold Korean citizenship.

## LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

TOEFL	IELTS	TEPS
iBT 80 or higher	5.5 or higher	600 or higher

\* Students from English speaking countries are exempt from the language proficiency requirement.



# Documents

## Freshmen only

---

- Official high school diploma or a document with the expected date of graduation
- Transcript of the last 3 years of high school

## Transfer only

---

- Official diploma (or certificate of completion) from previously attended universities
- Official transcript from previous attended universities



# Scholarship

---

Students with the highest interview scores will be granted full tuition scholarships for the first semester.

---

## Academic Excellence Scholarships

Students who exhibit an exemplary undergraduate record in the previous semester with a GPA ranked in the top 5% of registered students are eligible to receive this scholarship.

The KHU alumni association along with various other external organizations also provide scholarships for KIC students.
