# STUDY ABROAD SUMMER & WINTER PROGRAMS

## FUDAN UNIVERSITY

At Fudan University, located in Shanghai, China, KIC students participate in an international workshop focusing on China's politics, economy, society, culture, and foreign relations. Students also can experience and become immersed in Chinese culture by exploring the city of Shanghai, the center of China's economy.



## JOHNS HOPKINS UNIVERSITY

At the Johns Hopkins University Paul H. Nitze School of Advanced International Studies (SAIS), a preeminent school for graduate study in international affairs, students participate in the Short Course on American Foreign Policy (AFP) for four weeks. The course is accompanied by lectures and site visits to the World Bank, Pentagon, Capitol Hill, and other notable institutions.



## OSAKA UNIVERSITY

At the Osaka University School of International Public Policy (OSIPP), founded to facilitate research on issues and policies that transcend national, cultural, and other, students participate in workshops that help train them to acquire cross-disciplinary knowledge and advanced analytical capabilities required to resolve complex social problems.



# CAREER PROSPECTS

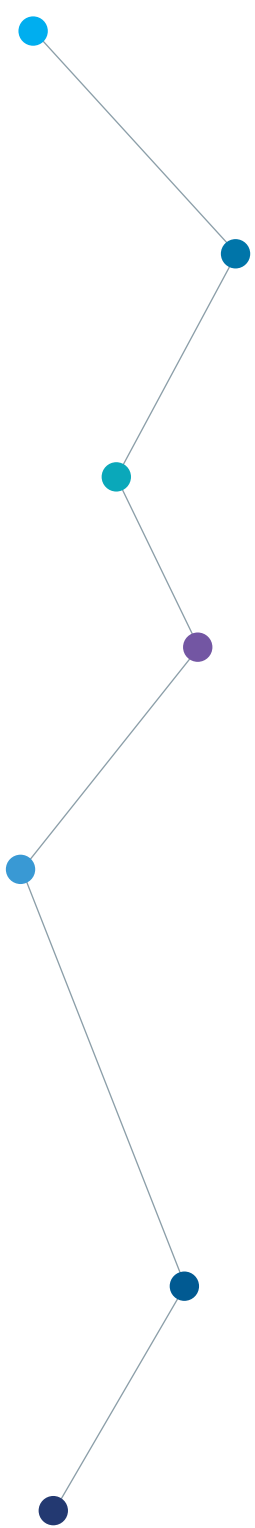
Our students have been consistently employed across a wide diversity of occupations in sectors including international trade, manufacturing, logistics, financing, accounting, and legal affairs.

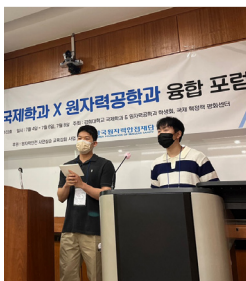

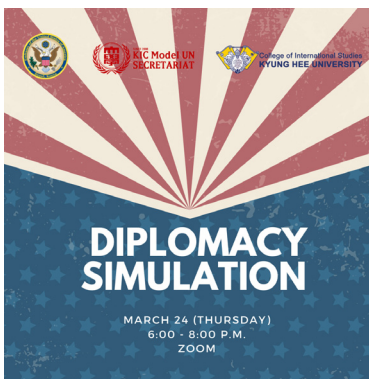
### HD Analysis: Business / Finance Society

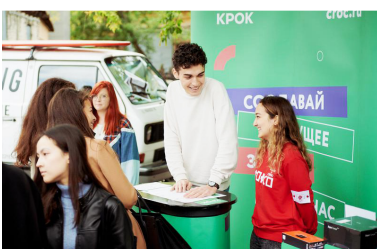
### Double Degree Program between KIC and Higher School of Economics at Moscow (HSE)

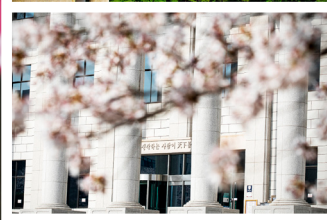
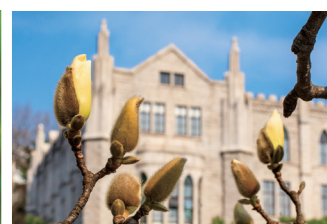
